# CONSIDER VARIANCE TO ALLOW A 15 FOOT ENCROACHMENT INTO THE 15 FOOT REAR BUILDING LINE FOR THE PLACEMENT OF A SWIMMING POOL SCREEN ENCLOSURE AT 112 ARROWWHEAD. LAKE JACKOSN.TEXAS
