

ORDINANCE NO. 16-2094

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAKE JACKSON, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 98 TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES TO DESIGNATE A PORTION OF SILVERBELL CIRCLE AS A NO PARKING ZONE; PROVIDING THAT ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH SHALL BE REPEALED TO THE EXTENT OF THE CONFLICT ONLY; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FIVE DAYS AFTER PUBLICATION

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE JACKSON, TEXAS:

Section 1: That Chapter 98 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lake Jackson is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 98-129.1

(a) *No parking zones designated.*

Anchusa, on the north side, from That Way to Royal Oak Circle, from the hours of 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. on school days.

Azalea Street, on the south side, from its intersection with Yaupon Street, 150 feet easterly.

Azalea Street, on the north side, from its intersection with Yaupon Street, 500 feet easterly to the drainage ditch, on Sundays.

Center Way, north side, along the Jasmine Hall property.

Center Way, from its intersection with Grapevine Turn to Oak Drive.

Circle Way, west side, from Oyster Creek Drive to 400 feet north of Oyster Creek Drive.

Circle Way, parkway side, 30 feet from the corner on all intersections along Circle Way from Oyster Creek Drive to Oak Drive.

Circle Way, both sides, from Winding Way to Oyster Creek Drive.

Grapevine Turn, both sides, entire street.

Indigo Street, both sides, from State Highway 332 to Silverbell Circle.

Ligustrum, north side, from Ash Lane to Narcissus Street, from the hours of 2:30 p.m. to 4 p.m. on school days.

Mimosa, both sides, easterly from South Oak Drive to the west property line of first house on Mimosa.

Narcissus, east side, across from the Jasmine Hall property.

Nasturtium, west side, across from Beutel School property.

Silverbell Circle, from Caraway Common to Chervil Common's northwestern intersection with Silverbell Circle.

State Highway 332, both sides, within the city limits.

That Way Street:

East side, from the drainage easement north of Mistletoe to the drainage easement south of Bougainvillea Street.

East side, for a distance of 25 feet immediately south of the exit lane of the circular drive in front of Bess Brannen Elementary School.

West side, from Oyster Creek Drive to a point 200 feet north of Oyster Creek Drive.

West side, from FM 2004 to Anchusa Street.

Winding Way Street, between Ney Elementary and First Baptist Church between the entrance and exit of the circular drive at the Baptist church.

Yaupon Street, east side, between Winding Way and Center Way, during school hours of Ney Elementary.

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 3: A violation of this ordinance shall be a Class C misdemeanor and the penalty for violating this ordinance shall be as provided for in Sec. 1-5 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lake Jackson.

Section 4: If any part or portion of this ordinance shall be invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect or impair any remaining portions or provisions of this ordinance.

Section 5: The City Secretary shall publish the caption of this ordinance within ten (10) days of final passage in the official newspaper of the City. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after publication in accordance with Section 3-15 of the Charter of the City of Lake Jackson, Texas.


