APPROVAL OF MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Yenne, seconded by Mr. Henderson, with all present members voting “aye,” the minutes were approved as presented.

REVIEW OF PREVIOUS REPORT AND CONFIRM CHANGES

- Mr. Yenne described the process of review and proposals from previous Charters.
- Mr. Brooks noted that, as each section is reviewed, they will look at the approved changes from the 2023 Charter and ensure those changes were accurately updated in the current Charter.
 - Mr. Yenne noted that he reviewed the changes and they have all been made.
- The commission reviewed the preamble.
- Discussions included the pros and cons of modernizing the language for the Charter and forming a task force/committee to review it.
- Discussed grammatical changes like adopting the use of the Oxford comma.
- There were no recommended changes to the preamble.
