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Application & Selection Process

The application period for Lake Jackson Youth Advisory Commission members is in the Fall, beginning in September and will normally run for approximately four weeks.

Application packets will be distributed to Lake Jackson public schools, private schools, home school associations, as well as non-profit, civic organizations, Lake Jackson Library, at City Hall and the Recreation Center.

Applications submitted prior to the established deadline are reviewed and qualified, selected candidates will be contacted to set up an interview to be conducted in early October.

The best candidates will be presented to the Lake Jackson City Council for their review and approval. City Council may accept the recommendations as made or may make any changes they deem appropriate.

Upon Council approval, letters are mailed to all interviewed candidates informing them of the membership appointments to the Lake Jackson Youth Advisory Commission.

Mission

The mission of the YAC is to provide local youth an active voice for the City of Lake Jackson and to improve youth involvement in the community.

Purpose

- Serve as the liaison between the youth of Lake Jackson and the City of Lake Jackson.
- Provide guidance and support for youth-focused programs and events.
- Provide input on youth services and programming to City Council and City Staff.
- Advocate for the needs of youth.
- Identify and carryout events that are important to youth.

Qualifications

The qualifications to join the Lake Jackson Youth Advisory Commission are as follows:

- Reside inside of Lake Jackson City Limits
- Be between the ages of 12-18
- Able to consistently attend regular meetings and events for the Lake Jackson Youth Advisory Commission
- Commitment to accomplishing the purpose of the Lake Jackson Youth Advisory Commission
- Ability to serve as an ambassador and voice for the Lake Jackson Youth Advisory Council



Governance

Officers of the Lake Jackson Youth Advisory Commission will be nominated and elected during the first meeting of the fall session and will serve for the duration of the school year.

Officers

Lake Jackson Youth Advisory Commission Officers are as follows:

- **President**
 - The President shall be responsible for facilitating meetings and ensuring that the Youth Advisory Commission is working together towards its mission and purpose. He/she/they are responsible for creating agendas based on current issues in the community and topics from previous meetings.
- **Vice-President**
 - The Vice-President shall assist the President and fulfil the responsibilities of the President if necessary.
- **Secretary**
 - The Secretary shall keep meeting minutes, record attendance, and assist the President in setting the agenda.
- **Treasurer**
 - The Treasurer shall see that the accounts of the Youth Advisory Commission are kept and maintained. This includes providing a monthly report of expenditures at each meeting.
- **Historian**
 - The Historian will oversee maintaining records of what the Youth Advisory Commission has done. This includes taking photographs at events and meetings, creating a scrapbook of the Youth Advisory



Commission, and collecting and maintaining any documents for the future of the Commission.

- Sergeant at Arms
 - The Sergeant at Arms will ensure all bylaws and traditions are respected by everyone. It is the Sergeant at Arms responsibility to enforce the rules, meaning any infractions or violations of the organization's policies must be reported to them.
- Energizer
 - The Energizers role is to start out every meeting with a fun and exciting icebreaker as well as greeting every member on the way in and out of meetings.
- Recruiter
 - The Recruiters role is to actively search for new members for the Youth Advisory Commission.
- Philanthropy Chair
 - The Philanthropy Chairs role is to reach out to different organizations and groups and see where the Youth Advisory Committee can assist.
- Social Media Chair
 - The Social Media Chairs role is to actively post and promote the Youth Advisory Council through different social media channels including but not limited to: Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat and TikTok. The Social Media Chair and Historian will work side and side together to ensure that photos are being taken and posted upon approval of City Liaison.
- Public Relations Chair
 - The Public Relations Chairs role is to serve as a liaison to Lake Jackson City Council along with serving as the point of contact for media who wish to know more about the Youth Advisory Commission.
- All officers will represent the Youth Advisory Commission to the public when called upon to do so.



Conduct Guidelines

As a role model and ambassador for the City of Lake Jackson, each Youth Advisory Commission member must conduct themselves in a positive, friendly, and law-abiding manner always.

All Youth Advisory Commission members, as well as their parent/guardian, will review and attest to the “Lake Jackson Youth Advisory Commission Honor Code/Role Model Responsibility” included in this packet as part of the application process.

Youth Advisory Commission members must attend 75% of all meetings and 50% of all events. If a member is unable to meet these requirements, they member may be removed from his/her/their office or membership by Lake Jackson Parks and Recreation.

The President shall send any member with two consecutive absences a written notice of attendance status.

Members shall immediately report instances of poor conduct to the Sergeant at Arms and the Lake Jackson Parks and Recreation Advisor.



Meeting Location

The regular meeting location of the Lake Jackson Youth Advisory Commission will be determined at the first meeting of the Youth Advisory Commission

If by any reason meetings need to be held at a different location, prior notification will be given to members and the public as to the change.

Meeting time shall be determined via vote at the first meeting of the Youth Advisory Commission.

Meeting locations and times are subject to change if voted on by the Officers of the Lake Jackson Youth Advisory Commission.
